

Guide for authors: *Aegyptiaca*. Journal of the History of Reception of Ancient Egypt

Please follow the guidelines given here when submitting or revising your article for publication. All submissions must be spell-checked, copy-edited and proof-read. Submitted texts must be consistent in terms of capitalisation, spelling, punctuation, abbreviations, references, headings etc.

The editors reserve the right to make editorial revisions in articles and reviews.

Articles must be submitted in English, German or French.

General

- Please submit all manuscripts for consideration by e-mail as a document formatted in “doc” or “docx”.
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Please use only footnotes and not endnotes. Footnotes should be numbered consecutively. In reviews of books, there should be no footnotes, all material being incorporated into the text.

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- References to information supplied by a modern editor must include page numbers.
- References to the classical text must include the standard identification numbers for that text, such as book and chapter numbers or Stephanus numbers. Use Arabic numbers for all divisions.
